

# Catch-Up Premium Plan 2016-17

The Catch-Up Premium was designed to support learners in Year 7 who were not "secondary ready" at the end of Key Stage 2. In the past this was targeted at students working below Level 4. Following the shift from levels to scaled scores in Year 6 SATs, there has been no new guidance on which students attract the Catch-Up Premium. The 2016-17 plan targets any student who did not meet national expectations in the Key Stage 2 SATs. The premium is worth £14,500 in 2016-17.

Our Catch-Up Plan is based around the Successmaker software which has been proven to raise standards amongst similar learners in other schools.
