

# **Post 16 Performance Data**

## **Achievement at Key Stage 5 - A-Levels**

The average grade achieved by students at Key Stage 5 in 2016 was a C-, based on 252 entries. Progress measures indicate that progress for academic subjects was in line with national averages.

## **Achievement at Key Stage 5 – Applied General**

There were 24 Applied General exams recorded in 2016. The average grade for these was a Distinction-. Progress measures indicate weaknesses for these 24, although in three cases the results date back to 2014 for courses which we no longer run.

## **Re-sits in English and Maths**

Seventeen students at the Centre who did not have a GCSE Grade C in either English or Maths re-sat their exams in the summer of 2016. Students re-sitting Maths did better than the national average with a progress score of 0.0. Students re-sitting English did worse than the national average with a progress score of -0.6.

## **Students completing their main course of study**

## **Destinations**

Destinations data relates to students who finished Post 16 study in 2014. 96% were still in education or employment in March 2015, well above the national average of 88%. 62% were in higher education (mainly university), again above the national average.
