- All fees stated are per candidate per paper/unit
- Exam board process times vary from a few days to a few weeks

Enquiry about Results and Access to Scripts

- Enquiries regarding reviews of marking **MUST** be made in writing or via email through the Exams Officer
- Candidate consent forms **MUST** also be completed for all post results services. These are available from the Exams Officer or can be accessed on the relevant exam board websites.
- Applications cannot be processed if a consent form is not completed
- A request for any of the post results services will not be accepted without payment in advance (<u>unless</u> The Academy has specifically requested your permission for a review of marking and has stated that The Academy will fund this request)
- Please make cheques payable to "The Elizabethan Academy". Informal discussion with subject teachers and/or senior staff together with the Exams Officer is advisable as a sensible step before your decision to proceed with an expensive review of marking.
- Reviews of marking can cost between £40 and £58 per unit, depending on the relevant exam board.
- Although we do not wish to discourage genuine requests, we must point out that it is only on rare occasions that grades are altered. Please remember marks can go down as well as up or will remain unchanged.
- No requests will be accepted after the relevant centre deadline.
- If there is a change in grade following a review of marking then your payment will be refunded as per exam board guidelines.
