- Exam board process times vary from a few days to a few weeks

Enquiry about Results and Access to Scripts

- Enquiries regarding reviews of marking **MUST** be made in writing or via email through the Exams Officer.
- Candidate consent forms **MUST** also be completed for all post results services. These are available from the Exams Officer or can be accessed on the website of the relevant exam board.
- Applications cannot be processed if a consent form is not completed.
- **A request for any of the post results services will not be accepted without payment in advance (unless The Academy has specifically requested your permission for a review of marking and has stated that The Academy will fund this request).**
- Please make cheques payable to “The Elizabethan Academy”. **Informal discussion with subject teachers and/or senior staff together with the Exams Officer is advisable as a sensible step before your decision to proceed with an expensive review of marking.**
- Reviews of marking can cost between £40 and £61.50 per unit, depending on the relevant exam board.
- Although we do not wish to discourage genuine requests, we must point out that it is only on rare occasions that grades are altered. **Please remember marks can go down as well as up or can remain unchanged.**
- No requests will be accepted after the relevant centre deadline.
- If there is a change in grade following a review of marking then your payment will be refunded as per exam board guidelines.
