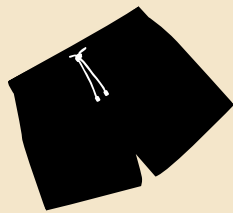

- **Grey blazer with The Elizabethan Academy badge .**
- **Grey tartan kilt** (Must sit on or below the knee).
- **Grey suit trousers** (Can be purchased from Trutex or various retail stockists, providing they match the colour of the blazer).
- **Grey tartan school tie** (Available from Trutex or our Finance Office in The Academy).
- **White long sleeved/short sleeved shirts** (Revered collared blouse can only be worn with the kilt (Can be purchased from various retail stockists))
- **Black tights, or white, grey or black socks** (Can be purchased from various retail stockists).
- **Grey tailored shorts** - knee length (optional Summer wear)
- **Black Shoes** - must be formal, plain, and suitable for School and wet weather. Logos and sports motifs are not allowed. For health and safety reasons, stilettoes, heels, canvas shoes, trainers, open toe shoes, or sandals are not allowed. (Can be purchased from various retail stockists)

Essential All Year Round

- **Grey/teal shorts or black leggings/jogging bottoms**
- **Grey/teal t-shirt or black top**
- **Grey/teal socks or plain socks**
- **Trainers**

Optional

- **Grey/teal reversible rugby top**
- **Grey/teal sweatshirt - short zip**
(suitable for colder days)
- **Black base layer top and bottoms/jogging bottoms** (winter wear)
- **Plain black sweatshirt**
- **Football boots** (for safety outdoors in winter)



All items of school clothing including PE kits and ties should be clearly marked with students name

Jewellery / Body Piercings/ Hairstyles

- Students are allowed a wristwatch, one pair of ear-rings (studs only) and one bracelet.
- Rings and necklaces are not permitted.
- Students are allowed to wear discreet make-up. Any student wearing an excessive amount of make-up, will be expected to remove it.
- They should not wear gel nails, acrylic nails or nail varnish. Extreme hairstyles are not allowed: this includes patterns cut into hair and colours other than those that could be natural (i.e., no reds, blues, greens etc). Hair length should be a minimum of grade 2.

Our uniform requirement is typical of most secondary schools across the UK. It is cost-effective and some items are available at various retail outlets. Home and school must continue to give the same consistent message to our young people by insisting they wear their full uniform correctly and with a sense of pride.
