- **Grey blazer with The Elizabethan Academy badge** (*Compulsory from Trutex*)
- **Grey tartan kilt** (*Unrolled at the waist, from Trutex*). **OR**
- **Grey suit trousers** (*Various retail stockists, formal style, graphite grey*).
- **Plain grey tailored shorts** (*Various retail stockists*)
- **White long/short sleeved standard collar** **OR**
- **Revered collar blouse/shirt** (*Various retail stockists*).
- **Grey tartan school tie** (*Available from Trutex - must be worn with the standard collar shirt*).
- **Plain Grey V-neck knitted jumper** (*Optional - worn under the blazer, no logos, unless school-branded from Trutex, various retail stockists*)
- **Black tights** **OR**
- **Plain black ankle socks** (*no logos/frills, various retail stockists*)
- **A school bag** (*Compulsory, large enough to carry A4 books and equipment. A separate bag for PE kit is permitted. Various retail stockists*)
- **A transparent pencil case containing at least:**
 - 2 black ink pens
 - 1 black dry-wipe whiteboard pen
 - 1 purple ink pen
 - 1 highlighter
 - 1 ruler
 - 1 rubber
 - 1 protractor
 - Scientific calculator (*Casio fx-83GT CW*)
 - The Elizabethan Values and Conduct Card (*which will be provided*)



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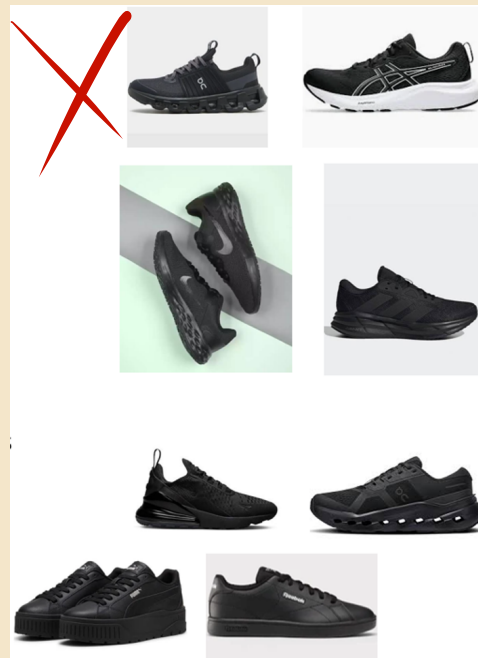
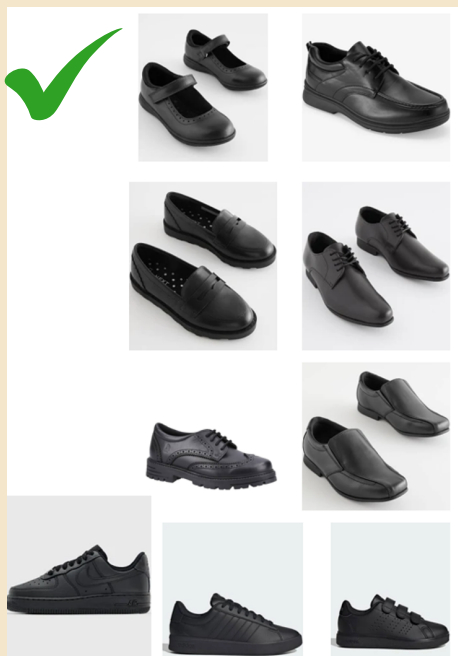


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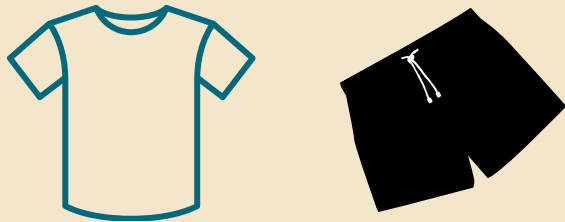
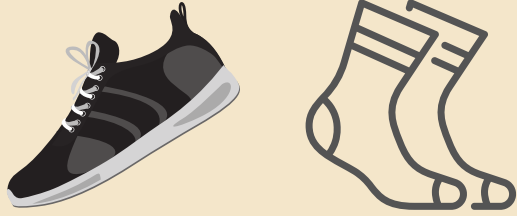
- **Plain black leather or faux-leather shoes OR**
- **Plain black leather or faux leather trainers** Footwear must be completely black upper, sole, laces, stitching with no coloured parts.

The following footwear/features are **NOT PERMITTED:**

- Any coloured branding or logos
- No coloured sections of the shoes - including stitching
- White or coloured soles
- Sports or running trainers
- Thick, curved or air-cushioned soles
- Canvas or fabric shoes
- Sandals or open-toe shoes
- Boots (including ankle boots)



PE KIT



Essential All Year Round

- **Grey/teal academy PE t-shirt** (Required)
- **Grey/teal shorts OR**
- **Plain black loose fitting shorts OR**
- **Black leggings/cycling shorts** minimum length 9inch in-seam with minimal branding
- **Sports socks**
- **Trainers**

Academy branded items available from Trutex, plain black essential wear available from various retailers

Optional

- **Grey/teal Academy sweatshirt - short zip**
- **Plain black base layer** (minimal branding, no hood)
- **Plain black tracksuit bottoms/leggings** (minimal branding)
- **Plain black quarter zip or plain black round-neck sweatshirt** (Minimal branding and no hoods)
- **Football/Astro boots**

Jewellery / Body Piercings/ Hairstyles

- Students are allowed a wristwatch (not a smartwatch) and one pair of stud earrings, and can wear a flat, discreet, clear nose stud.
- Smartwatches are not permitted as they work in a similar way to a mobile phone
- No other jewellery is permitted, e.g. rings, bracelets, hoop earrings and other piercings, unless there are medical or religious reasons.
- Students are allowed to wear discreet make-up. Any student wearing an excessive amount of make-up, will be expected to remove it. False eyelashes are not allowed.
- Students must have short nails (**no visible length beyond the fingertip**) which are neutral in colour. Excessive length, gel, acrylic, false, BIAB nails are not allowed and students will be expected to remove them
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted: this includes patterns cut into hair and colours other than those that are natural (i.e., no reds, blues, greens etc).

Our uniform requirement is typical of most secondary schools across the UK. It is cost-effective and most items are available from various retail outlets. Home and school must continue to give the same consistent message to our young people by insisting they wear their full uniform correctly and with a sense of pride.

We firmly believe that smart students demonstrate a good work ethic that contributes to effective learning.
