Where to find your Maths work

The Maths Faculty have set up tasks to be completed on Mymaths.co.uk, the students are familiar with this site and they have the log-in details to access the work. The teaching staff are setting the work for their own groups on a weekly basis, usually Monday of the new week, and a maximum of 7 tasks in a week. When the student enters their portal each task is listed and each task has a Set Date and a Due Date so that you can see how your child is progressing with the work for that week and if there are any overdue pieces of work.

Each task has a Lesson and a Homework part to it, the lesson needs to be completed first followed by the homework task. Students must make every effort to replicate work in the classroom by working through the problems before committing to an answer. The teacher has the details of who has completed the work, how long it took and the score that they achieved. The tasks that are being set are linked to the Scheme of Learning that we would be following, for the remainder of this year, if the school was open and so it is important that students make every effort to complete them on time.

Year 11 Working at Home Guidance

As you will already be aware, Year 11 will not sit their exams this summer; the Government has announced instead that students will be awarded a grade which fairly reflects the work that they have put in. There will also be an option to sit an exam early in the next academic year for students who wish to. The exam boards will be asking teachers to submit their judgement about the grade that they believe the student would have received if exams had gone ahead.

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So what should Year 11 students be working on at the moment since exams are not going ahead in June?

- Where possible, they should complete any outstanding coursework in case this is needed as evidence and submit it as soon as possible to their class teacher.
- Continue learning and revising all their GCSE subjects in case they need to sit any exams in the next academic year. This includes completing past papers and exam questions which teachers will give feedback on.
- Begin preparing for A Level. On the school website (Menu - Sixth Form - A Level Preparation Summer Tasks) are resources to ensure students get a head start on their chosen subjects.
