In preparation for the start of the music course in September, you are required to prepare the following 3 tasks:



Western Classical Tradition (Development of the Symphony 1750-1900)

- Prepare a presentation about The Orchestra – include instruments, instrument families, roles and how the orchestra developed from the Baroque to Modern eras. Use Word, Power Point, Publisher or any other program you are comfortable with.

Notation/Theory



- Use <https://www.musictheory.net> to revise the following:
 - the concept of the Circle of Fifths
 - major and minor scales in treble, bass, tenor and alto clefs
 - primary & secondary triads
 - cadences

You will be tested on these in the first lessons of the course

Performing

- Prepare a performance of a piece on your main instrument or voice



Play something you are comfortable with, that shows your strengths. It can be unaccompanied or accompanied by a backing track, piano, guitar etc (but you may need to organise accompanists)

Time limit: at least 1 minute - no more than 3 minutes.
